In 1994, famed golf course architect Pete Dye walked what was then the North Course of the Purdue University Golf Courses. His goal was to come up with possible changes that could be made due to an upcoming road construction project. Dye's plan became much more than a simple renovation. His personal goal was to produce a golf course that would be both a challenge to the collegiate golfer and act as a classroom for the students of Purdue.

The result of the Purdue-Dye collusion is the Kampen-Cosler Course, a unique links-style layout with strategically placed waste bunkers, native grasslands, man-made wetlands and large greens. Measuring over 7,400 yards from the championship tees and just over 5,000 from the forward tees, it's a true test of golf for all players. Difficulty exponentially increases as the tee-choice moves back so great emphasis should be placed on the proper set of tees to play.



Have you ever played Pinehurst No. 2 or Torrey Pines? If so, you know the special feeling of golfing at a distinctive venue. We are excited to have created our own distinctive venue under the creative magic of world-renowned golf course architect Pete Dye.

Ackerman-Allen – formerly the Purdue South Course and later Ackerman Hills – originally was designed by Indiana Golf Hall of Famer Bill Diddle and built in 1934. It hosted the 1961 NCAA Men's Championships at which Purdue won the team title and Jack Nicklaus was the medalist. The course was modified in 1968 by Larry Packard to accommodate the expansion of the Tower Acres residential area. It was further developed from 1996 to 1998 as part of the opening of the Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex.

The Ackerman-Allen Course, is a parkland-style course with bentgrass greens, fairways and tees as well. With rolling hills, tree-lined fairways, white sand bunkers, and minimal water hazards, the Ackerman-Allen Course suits golfers of all abilities.

Both course are now included on the Pete Dye Trail, which presently consists of seven unique and challenging golf courses throughout Indiana.



KAMPEN-COSLER: AMONG THE NATION'S BEST GOLF COURSES

Kampen-Cosler is rated one of the top collegiate courses in the nation and has been awarded 4.5 stars on Golf Digest's "Places to Play." It is ranked as one of the most difficult golf courses in Indiana. The course has also played host to a number of prestigious collegiate and public tournaments.

The Kampen-Cosler Course has earned national acclaim from many that have played it. "They could have a U.S. Open here and it would be a good test," said longtime UNLV men's golf head coach Dwaine Knight after the 2017 NCAA Regionals. "You could host any tournament you wanted here."

Weekly Team League

The Team League consists of 32 teams divided into two 16-team divisions. Weekly matches involve two players from one team facing off against two players from another team in a Two Man Best Ball format. Teams accumulate season-long points, and the top 3 teams from each division advance to the playoffs. Each team plays every other team in their division once, with matches scheduled for 9 holes, rotating throughout the season. The League starts at 5:30 p.m. every Tuesday from May-September. Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex Members play for free each week as part of their membership!

Do I have to be a member to golf on Kampen-Cosler Course?

Yes. The Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex is considered a semi-private facility. A person must be a member or have an affiliation with Purdue to golf on the Kampen-Cosler course. To play Kampen-Cosler, golfers must be a member or part of one of the following affiliated groups:

- » Purdue full-time students
- » Purdue faculty and staff
- » Parents of Purdue students
- » Members of the John Purdue Club
- » Guests of affiliated golfers

Can anyone join the Birck Boilermaker Golf Complex?

Yes. Memberships are open year-round. To join the BBGC, contact our Pro Shop who can assist you with the application process and answer any questions.

Can anyone golf on Ackerman-Allen?

Yes. You do not have to be affiliated with Purdue or be a member of the facility to play on the Ackerman-Allen course.

Why did you change your policy on course access?

This policy ensures that our community and its supporters enjoy an excellent golfing experience while maintaining our facility's connection to the University. It also ensures that the course remains in excellent condition for our Purdue golf teams.

Do John Purdue Club members still get their discounts?

Yes. John Purdue Club members still receive the same BBGC benefits they received in previous years.

Do you have a dress code?

Yes. Proper "golf attire" is required at all times to play and practice; this includes the off-season.

- » Men: Collared shirts are required; No tank tops, tee shirts, cut-offs, sweatpants, athletic shorts, and no jeans or denim. Slacks or Khakis are appropriate.
- » Women: Skirts, dresses, blouses, collared shirt (golf shirt of any kind) are all appropriate attire. Shorts may be worn if they are NOT athletic shorts, blue jean or denim. Leggings or yoga pants may only be worn under skirts, skorts, and golf dresses.
- » Shoes: Acceptable golf shoes must be worn at all times on the golf course and practice facilities. Acceptable golf shoes do not include sandals, flip flops, metal spikes, or other footwear detrimental to turf.

Will the new clubhouse improve my experience as a member?

Yes. The opening of the Pete Dye Clubhouse will enhance the member experience we offer. Our new facility will include locker rooms with daily-use lockers and showers, the option for golf bag storage, a new putting green located off the clubhouse patio, and improved offerings in the Purdue Pro Shop.
